9 "(2) In undertaking the commission's responsibilities under sub-10 section (1) of this section, the commission shall consider reports, 11 findings and recommendations that have been or will be issued by 12 legislative and agency task forces, work groups and committees that 13 have undertaken study, review or oversight of the foster care system 14 in this state.

"(3) The commission may establish any advisory or technical com-15 mittees the commission considers necessary to aid and advise the 16 commission in the performance of its functions. The committees may 17 be continuing or temporary committees. The commission shall deter-18 mine the representation, membership, terms and organization of the 19 committees and shall appoint the members of the committees. Mem-20bers of the committees are not entitled to compensation but, in the 21discretion of the commission, may be reimbursed from funds available 22to the commission for actual and necessary travel and other expenses 23incurred by the members in the performance of official duties in the 24manner and amount provided in ORS 292.495. 25

"(4) The commission may adopt rules to carry out the provisions
 of this section.

"<u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
