- "(a) 'Law enforcement unit' has the meaning given that term in 8 ORS 181A.355.
- 9 "(b) 'Police officer' has the meaning given that term in ORS 133.525.
- "(2) A law enforcement unit may file a petition with the circuit court where the law enforcement unit is located, on behalf of a police officer, to require the law enforcement unit to withhold from disclosure the name, home address, electronic mail address, telephone number, date of birth and other identifying information of the police officer, or members of the police officer's immediate family, only if, by clear and convincing evidence, the police officer can demonstrate
- 17 that the police officer, or a member of the police officer's immediate
- 18 family, has received a credible threat of danger to the life of the police
- 19 officer or a member of the police officer's immediate family.
- 20 "(3) All proceedings related to the petition must be held in camera.
 - "(4) The court shall enter an order granting or denying the petition

within five business days after the date on which the petition is filed.

"(5) The law enforcement unit shall withhold from disclosure the identifying information described in subsection (2) of this section while the petition is pending review by the court.".
