**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 4083**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “amending ORS 443.886” and  
2 insert “and declaring an emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Alzheimer’s Care Units is es-**  
5 **tablished.**

6 **“(2) The task force consists of nine members appointed as follows:**

7 **“(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint one member from**  
8 **among members of the Senate.**

9 **“(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one**  
10 **member from among members of the House of Representatives.**

11 **“(c) The Governor shall appoint the following members:**

12 **“(A) One representative of the Department of Human Services with**  
13 **expertise in licensing and rules.**

14 **“(B) One representative of the Department of Human Services with**  
15 **expertise in aging and people with disabilities.**

16 **“(C) One representative of the Department of Human Services with**  
17 **expertise in community based care.**

18 **“(D) One representative of the office of the Long Term Care Om-**  
19 **budsman.**

20 **“(E) One member representing a statewide association of long term**  
21 **care facilities.**

1       **“(F) One member representing a statewide association related to**  
2 **Alzheimer’s disease.**

3       **“(G) One member representing nonprofit Alzheimer’s care units.**

4       **“(3) The task force shall study the licensing and regulation of**  
5 **Alzheimer’s care units.**

6       **“(4) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a**  
7 **quorum for the transaction of business.**

8       **“(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a**  
9 **majority of the members of the task force.**

10       **“(6) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as**  
11 **chairperson.**

12       **“(7) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority**  
13 **shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.**

14       **“(8) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the**  
15 **call of the chairperson or of a majority of the members of the task**  
16 **force.**

17       **“(9) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of**  
18 **the task force.**

19       **“(10) The task force shall submit a report in the manner provided**  
20 **by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to**  
21 **an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to human**  
22 **services no later than September 15, 2016.**

23       **“(11) The Department of Human Services shall provide staff support**  
24 **to the task force.**

25       **“(12) Members of the task force who are not members of the Leg-**  
26 **islative Assembly are not entitled to compensation, but may be reim-**  
27 **bursed for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by**  
28 **them in the performance of their official duties in the manner and**  
29 **amounts provided for in ORS 292.495. Claims for expenses incurred in**  
30 **performing functions of the task force shall be paid out of funds ap-**

1 **propriated to the Department of Human Services for purposes of the**  
2 **task force.**

3 **“(13) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,**  
4 **are directed to assist the task force in the performance of the task**  
5 **force’s duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to**  
6 **confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the**  
7 **task force consider necessary to perform their duties.**

8 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2016 Act is repealed on December 31,**  
9 **2017.**

10 **“SECTION 3. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
11 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
12 **declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
