"SECTION 2. (1) The Water Quality Monitoring Fund is established in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Water Quality Monitoring Fund shall be credited to the fund. The fund consists of moneys deposited in the fund under section 1 of this 2016 Act and may include moneys appropriated, allocated, deposited or transferred to the fund by the Legislative Assembly or otherwise and interest earned on moneys in the fund.

"(2) Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board to be used for the purposes described in section 1 of this 2016 Act.

"SECTION 3. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect on its passage."
