- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon insert "creating 1 new provisions; and". On page 4, after line 18, insert: 3 "SECTION 4. Section 5 of this 2016 Act is added to and made a part 4 of the wildlife laws. 5 "SECTION 5. A person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum 6 term of incarceration of 180 days, without reduction for any reason, 7 if: 8 9
 - "(1) The person is convicted of a violation of the wildlife laws, or any rule adopted pursuant to the wildlife laws, or a failure to comply with the requirements of a citation in connection with any such offense; and
 - "(2) At the time of conviction, the person is subject to a prohibition by a court or the State Fish and Wildlife Commission under ORS 496.992 (12) or 497.415 from applying for or obtaining all licenses, tags or permits issued pursuant to the wildlife laws.".
