**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4134**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “171.735,”.

2 Delete lines 5 through 30.

3 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 6.

4 In line 7, delete “3” and insert “1”.

5 On page 3, delete lines 29 through 32 and insert:

6 “(d) Lobbyist registration statements and revisions and updates to
7 lobbyist registration statements filed under ORS 171.740. The information
8 required under this paragraph must be available in a searchable format for
9 review by the public using the Internet not later than one calendar day after
10 the lobbyist files the information with the commission.”.

11 Delete lines 33 through 45.

12 Delete page 4.

13 On page 5, delete lines 1 through 6 and insert:

14 “**SECTION 2.** ORS 171.740 is amended to read:

15 “171.740. (1) Within [10] **three** business days after exceeding the limit of
16 time or expenditure specified in ORS 171.735 (4), or within [10] **three** busi-
17 ness days after agreeing to provide personal services for money or any other
18 consideration for the purpose of lobbying, a lobbyist shall register with the
19 Oregon Government Ethics Commission by filing with the commission a
20 statement containing the following information:

21 “(a) The name, address, **electronic mail address** and telephone number

1 of the lobbyist.

2 “(b) The name, address, **electronic mail address** and telephone number
3 of each person that employs the lobbyist or in whose interest the lobbyist
4 appears or works.

5 “(c) A general description of the trade, business, profession or area of
6 endeavor of any person designated under paragraph (b) of this subsection,
7 and a statement by the person that the lobbyist is officially authorized to
8 lobby for the person.

9 “(d) The name of any member of the Legislative Assembly employed, re-
10 tained or otherwise compensated by:

11 “(A) The lobbyist designated under paragraph (a) of this subsection; or

12 “(B) A person designated under paragraph (b) of this subsection.

13 “(e) The general subject or subjects of the legislative action of interest
14 to the person for whom the lobbyist is registered.

15 “(2)(a) **Not later than 10 calendar days after a lobbyist files a regis-**
16 **tration statement under this section,** the designation of official authori-
17 zation to lobby shall be signed by an official of each person that employs the
18 lobbyist or in whose interest the lobbyist appears or works.

19 “(b) **A lobbyist may unilaterally withdraw a registration statement**
20 **filed under this section not more than one time per calendar year for**
21 **each person designated under subsection (1)(b) of this section if the**
22 **withdrawal is made:**

23 “(A) **Before the designation of official authorization to lobby has**
24 **been signed in the manner required under paragraph (a) of this sub-**
25 **section; and**

26 “(B) **No more than 10 calendar days after the lobbyist filed the**
27 **registration statement.**

28 “(3) A lobbyist must file a separate registration statement under **sub-**
29 **section (1) of** this section for each person that employs the lobbyist or in
30 whose interest the lobbyist appears or works. If a lobbyist appears or works

1 for a person for whom the lobbyist has not registered, the lobbyist shall
2 register with the commission not later than [10] **three** business days after
3 the day the lobbyist first appears or works for the person.

4 “(4)(a) **Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection**, if any
5 of the information submitted by a lobbyist in the statement required under
6 subsection (1) of this section changes, the lobbyist shall revise the statement
7 within 30 days of the change.

8 “(b) **A lobbyist shall notify the commission within three business**
9 **days if the lobbyist ceases to represent a person for whom the lobbyist**
10 **is registered. Notification must be made by updating the registration**
11 **statement required under subsection (1) of this section.**

12 “(5) A lobbyist registration expires December 31 of each odd-numbered
13 year. If a lobbyist renews the registration before January 31 of the following
14 even-numbered year, the commission shall consider the registration to have
15 been effective as of December 31 of the odd-numbered year on which the
16 registration expired.

17 “(6) For the statement required by **subsection (1) of this section**, an en-
18 tity [*comprised*] **composed** of more than one lobbyist may file one statement
19 for the lobbyists who [*comprise*] **compose** the entity. The statement the en-
20 tity files must include the names of the individuals authorized to lobby on
21 behalf of the client listed in the statement.

22 “**SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 171.740 and 244.290 by**
23 **sections 1 and 2 of this 2016 Act apply to lobbyist registration state-**
24 **ments and updates or revisions to lobbyist registration statements**
25 **filed on or after January 1, 2017.”.**

26 In line 7, delete “7” and insert “4”.

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
