**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 1511**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete “and 475B.375” and insert “,  
2 475B.375 and 475B.625”.

3 On page 14, after line 35, insert:

5 **“DOSAGE**

7 **“SECTION 16a.** ORS 475B.625 is amended to read:  
8

9 **“475B.625. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section,** the Oregon  
10 Health Authority shall adopt rules establishing:

11 **“(a) The maximum concentration of tetrahydrocannabinol that is permit-**  
12 **ted in a single serving of a cannabinoid product or cannabinoid concentrate**  
13 **or extract; and**

14 **“(b) The number of servings that are permitted in a cannabinoid product**  
15 **or cannabinoid concentrate or extract package.**

16 **“(2) For purposes of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395, rules adopted under**  
17 **subsection (1) of this section:**

18 **(a) Must be calculated so that the minimum weight of**  
19 **tetrahydrocannabinol permitted in a single serving of a cannabinoid**  
20 **edible is not less than 10 milligrams; and**

21 **“(b) Must allow there to be at least 10 servings in a cannabinoid**  
**edible package.**

1        “[2] (3) In adopting rules under ORS 475B.400 to 475B.525, the authority  
2 shall require all usable marijuana, cannabinoid products and cannabinoid  
3 concentrates and extracts transferred by a medical marijuana dispensary  
4 registered under ORS 475B.450 to meet the concentration **and packaging**  
5 standards adopted by rule pursuant to [*subsection (1) of*] this section.

6        “[3] (4) In adopting rules under ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395, the Oregon  
7 Liquor Control Commission shall require all usable marijuana, cannabinoid  
8 products and cannabinoid concentrates and extracts sold or transferred by  
9 a marijuana retailer that holds a license under ORS 475B.110 to meet the  
10 concentration **and packaging** standards adopted by rule pursuant to [*sub-*  
11 *section (1) of*] this section.”.
