"SECTION 8. Section 9 of this 2016 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475B.600 to 475B.655.

"SECTION 9. (1) In adopting rules under ORS 475B.625 (1), the Oregon Health Authority may not impose a limit on the maximum amount of tetrahydrocannabinol permitted in a package of a cannabinoid product or cannabinoid concentrate or extract if the limit on the maximum amount of tetrahydrocannabinol permitted is less than:

- "(a) For cannabinoid products other than cannabinoid edibles and for cannabinoid concentrates and extracts processed to be used only by individuals who hold a valid registry identification card issued under ORS 475B.415, 4,000 milligrams per package;
- "(b) For cannabinoid edibles processed to be used only by individuals who hold a valid registry identification card issued under ORS 475B.415, 1,000 milligrams per package;
- 20 "(c) For cannabinoid products other than cannabinoid edibles and 21 for cannabinoid concentrates and extracts processed to be used by any

- individual of legal age, 1,000 milligrams per package; and
- "(d) For cannobinoid edibles processed to be used by any individual of legal age, 100 milligrams per package.
- "(2) In adopting rules under ORS 475B.625 (1), the authority may not impose a limit on the maximum amount of tetrahydrocannabinol permitted in a single serving of a cannabinoid edible if the limit on the maximum amount of tetrahydrocannabinol permitted is less than 10 milligrams per single serving.
- 9 "(3) This section does not apply to a cannabinoid product that is 10 intended only to be applied to a person's skin or hair.".
