"(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund 15appropriation made to the Department of Human Services by section 16 1 (3), chapter 760, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium beginning July 17 1, 2015, for aging and people with disabilities and 18 intellectual/developmental disabilities programs, is increased by 19 \$1,542,919 for administering the general assistance project described in 20section 1 of this 2016 Act. 21

"(3) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-22tation on expenditures established by section 2 (4), chapter 760, Oregon 23Laws 2015, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum 24limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, 25including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare receipts and including 26federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental 27Security Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, 28but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 29 2, chapter 760, Oregon Laws 2015, collected or received by the Depart-30

ment of Human Services, for shared services, is increased by \$65,348
for administering the general assistance project described in section 1
of this 2016 Act.

<u>SECTION 11.</u> This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
