**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4110**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after “ORS” insert
2 “305.035, 305.065.”

3 On page 3, after line 19, insert:

4 **“SECTION 4.** ORS 305.035 is amended to read:

5 “305.035. (1) The Department of Revenue shall be under the supervision
6 of the Director of the Department of Revenue who shall be appointed for a
7 term of four years and shall hold office at the pleasure of the Governor. The
8 director shall be skilled and expert in matters of taxation **or financial ad-**
9 **ministration** and shall devote the entire time of the director to the per-
10 formance of the duties imposed upon the department.

11 “(2) The appointment of the director is subject to confirmation by the
12 Senate under ORS 171.562 and 171.565. In case the Governor’s choice of a
13 director is not confirmed, the Governor shall make another appointment
14 subject to the confirmation by the Senate as provided in this subsection.

15 “(3) The director shall receive such salary as may be provided by law. In
16 addition to salary, the director, subject to the limitations otherwise provided
17 by law, shall be reimbursed for all reasonable expenses necessarily incurred
18 by the director in the performance of official duties. Before entering upon
19 the duties of office, the director shall be bonded under ORS 291.011.

20 **“SECTION 5.** ORS 305.065 is amended to read:

21 “305.065. The Director of the Department of Revenue, with the approval

1 of the Governor, may designate a deputy director, to serve at the pleasure
2 of the director, with full authority to act for the director, but subject to the
3 control of the director. The deputy director shall be skilled and expert in
4 matters of taxation **or financial administration** and shall devote the entire
5 time of the deputy director to the performance of the duties of the deputy
6 director in the department. The designation of a deputy director shall be by
7 written order filed with the Secretary of State.

8 **“SECTION 6. Section 7 of this 2016 Act is added to and made a part**
9 **of ORS 469B.270 to 469B.306.**

10 **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding ORS 469B.285 (6), a preliminary cer-**
11 **tificate issued under ORS 469B.288 shall remain valid until August 31,**
12 **2016, for a project:**

13 **“(1) That is to be constructed or installed in a county with an area**
14 **in excess of 10,000 square miles; and**

15 **“(2) For which preliminary certification currently expires on June**
16 **28, 2016.”.**

17 In line 20, delete “4” and insert “8”.

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
