Oregon has a long history of engaging citizens in the democratic process by allowing us to block dangerous legislation through the referral process.

In the case of R301, however, it's the referral itself that is dangerous to the citizens of Oregon. And when people are given the option to sign the petition to qualify it for the ballot, they need to know EXACTLY what they're signing. They need to know EXACTLY how their lives will be impacted. They need to know EXACTLY how many lives will be impacted.

For these reasons, I urge you to include the following information in the R301 ballot title:

- 375,000 Oregonians will have their health care jeopardized
- 200,000+ Oregonians who purchase insurance individually will see at least a 6 percent increase in their premiums
