OFFICE: Oregon Liquor Control Commission

APPOINTEE: Matthew Maletis of Portland; New appointment replacing Rice

TERM: Partial four-year term: November 17, 2017 – March 31, 2021

APPOINTMENT/CONFIRMATION AUTHORITY: ORS 471.705

STATEMENT OF ECONOMIC INTEREST REQUIRED (ORS 244.050): Required.

STATUTORY QUALIFICATIONS: ORS 471.705, 471.710

Affirmative action policy: See ORS 182.100. Diversity criteria: See ORS 236.115.

- Seven members appointed by the Governor, one from each congressional district, no more than four from the same political party, one from the food and alcoholic beverage retail industry (RICE), with the chair (ROSENBAUM) designated by Governor
 - Congressional District 1 - MALETIS (R)
 - Congressional District 2 - Vacant (R)
 - Congressional District 3 - WEATHERSPOON (D)
 - Congressional District 4 - REVOAL (D)
 - Congressional District 5 - HARPER (D)
- One must be from Eastern Oregon - CURRIN
- One must be from Western Oregon - ROSENBAUM
- Not less than 30 years of age; must be resident of the state for five years
- Eligible for reappointment but may not serve more than two full terms
- May not have financial interest in any business licensed by the commission (Exempt: Food and Alcoholic Beverage Retail Industry Representative)
- Removable by Governor for cause after hearing

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: ORS 471.710, 471.720, 471.725, 471.730, 472.060, 473.020

- Appoint Administrator
- Buy, bottle, and sell liquor; regulate manufacture, possession, sale, purchase, transportation, importation and delivery of liquor; grant, suspend, cancel or refuse licenses or permits to manufacture or sell liquor; regulate liquor advertising; adopt rules and regulations
- Acquire property and equipment, lease property; borrow money guaranteed by pledge of goods
- Collect taxes on liquor; administer liquor manufacturing and importing tax
- Investigate violations
- Exercise powers incidental, convenient or necessary
- Grant, refuse, suspend or cancel licenses for the sale of liquor upon premises for consumption
- Establish by rule additional restrictions to membership to prohibit potential conflicts of interest
