## CJC compiled adult sentencing data that shows

- Individuals under 18 on the crime commit date
- Individuals under 20 on the admission date
- Estimated release date is between the 25<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> Birthday
  - Individual will transfer from OYA facility to adult facility at age 25 and will have 24 months or less left on total sentence

- The yearly average is 5 cases a year that are expected to age-out to DOC
- The average length of stay at DOC is about 10 months
- Of 65 total cases, 58 have Measure 11 sentences
