Summary of Legislative Concepts to be Introduced as Committee Measures December 14, 2018

- LC 2998 Requires Dept of Education to support programs related to and statewide conference on bullying prevention and youth empowerment.
- LC 1952 Requires Dept of Human Services to administer palliative care pilot project supporting provision of community-based end of life care.
- LC 1950 Permits health care representative to make election for hospice treatment on behalf of incapacitated individual with terminal condition without valid advance directive.
- LC 1948 Requires licensed hospice programs to identify patients in need of palliative care, provide information about and facilitate access to palliative care.
- LC 1027 Aligns definitions on mental health services bill of rights with definitions applicable to reporting of abuse of persons with mental illness.
- LC 3049 Modifies definition of "child-caring agency" to include certain residential facilities.
- LC 3211 Modifies definition of "child-caring agency" to include county programs providing care/services to children in DHS or OYA custody.
- LC 1239 Expands programs serving behavioral health needs of seniors and persons with disabilities.
- LC 1240 Establishes Center of Excellence on Behavioral Health for Older Adults and People with Disabilities.

- LC 1241 Requires Dept of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority to convene stakeholder group to develop recommendations for ensuring clients have seamless, uninterrupted access to mental health and substance abuse programs and long term care services and supports.
- LC 1878 Requires certain filling stations, service stations, garages and other dispensaries to provide equal access (refueling assistance) to persons with disabilities.
- LC 1174 Placeholder, relating to child care.
- LC 1175 Placeholder, relating to child safety.
- LC 1176 Placeholder, relating to child welfare.
- LC 1177 Placeholder, relating to children.
- LC 1178 Placeholder, relating to developmental disabilities.
- LC 3132 Placeholder, relating to the regulation of child care providers.
