## **SUMMARY**

Provides that person who is arrested for or convicted of criminal offense for which person serves jail term or term of imprisonment and whose arrest or conviction court of competent jurisdiction vacates, reverses, sets aside or otherwise countermands because of negligent or reckless conduct in investigation, charging or prosecution of offense has cause of action against state for wrongful incarceration.

- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. A person who is arrested for or convicted of a criminal
- 5 offense for which the person serves a jail term or term of
- 6 imprisonment and whose arrest or conviction a court of competent
- 7 jurisdiction vacates, reverses, sets aside, or otherwise countermands,
- 8 because of negligent or reckless conduct in the investigation, charging
- 9 or prosecution of the offense has a cause of action against the state
- 10 for wrongful incarceration. The person may recover damages in an
- 11 amount the court determines is reasonably proportional to the length
- 12 of the term of imprisonment that the person served.
