SUMMARY

Provides that conditioning employment on refraining from using any substance that is lawful to use in this state is unlawful employment practice. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT
Relating to unlawful employment practices; amending ORS 659A.315; and
declaring an emergency.
Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
SECTION 1. ORS 659A.315 is amended to read:
659A.315. (1) It is an unlawful employment practice for any employer to
require, as a condition of employment, that any employee or prospective
employee refrain from using [lawful tobacco products] a substance that is
lawful to use under the laws of this state during nonworking hours, ex-
cept when the restriction relates to:
(a) A bona fide occupational [requirement.] qualification; or
(b) The performance of work while impaired.
(2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply if an applicable collective
bargaining agreement prohibits off-duty use of [tobacco products] the sub-
stance.
SECTION 2. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate pres-
ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-

clared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage.

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
