SUMMARY

Allows counties to approve second dwelling on forestlands near existing dwelling for relative of owner who supports owner's forestry practices.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to forest dwellings. 2

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- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3
- SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part 4 of ORS chapter 197. 5
- SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "owner or a relative" means 6
- the owner of the lot or parcel, or a relative of the owner or the owner's
- spouse, including a child, parent, stepparent, grandchild, grandparent, 8
- stepgrandparent, sibling, stepsibling, niece, nephew or first cousin of 9 either. 10
- (2) A county may approve a new single-family dwelling unit on a lot 11 or parcel zoned for forest use provided: 12
- (a) The new single-family dwelling unit will be on a lot or parcel 13 no smaller than the minimum size allowed under ORS 215.780;
- (b) The new single-family dwelling unit will be on a lot or parcel 15 that contains exactly one existing single-family dwelling unit that was 16 lawfully: 17
- (A) In existence before November 4, 1993; or 18
- (B) Approved under ORS 215.130 (6), 215.705, 215.720, 215.740, 215.750 19 or 215.755; 20
 - (c) The shortest distance between the new single-family dwelling

1	unit and the existing single-family dwelling unit is no greater than 200
2	feet;
3	(d) The existing single-family dwelling unit is occupied by the owner
4	or a relative;
5	(e) The new single-family dwelling unit will be occupied by the
6	owner or a relative; and
7	(f) The owner or a relative occupies the new single-family dwelling
8	unit to allow the relative to assist in the harvesting, processing or
9	replanting of forest products or in the management, operation, plan-
10	ning, acquisition or supervision of forest lots or parcels of the owner.

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
