SUMMARY

Requires forensic laboratory to test blood or urine sample within 90 days of receiving sample in prosecution of driving while under influence of intoxicants.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to driving while under the influence of intoxicants.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, “forensic laboratory” means a forensic laboratory established by the Department of State Police under ORS 181A.150 that is accredited by a national forensic accrediting organization.

(2) Within 90 days of receiving a blood or urine sample in a prosecution of driving while under the influence of intoxicants under ORS 813.010, a forensic laboratory shall test a person’s blood or urine to determine the alcoholic content of the person’s blood or urine, or both, and for the purpose of determining the presence of cannabis, a controlled substance or an inhalant in the person.
