Affirmative action policy: See ORS 182.100. Diversity criteria: See ORS 236.115.

- Eight members appointed by the Governor to three-year terms including:
 - Three must be licensed as professional counselors (DALTON, McGRATH, THOMSON)
 - Two must be licensed as marriage and family therapists (HARMAN, MICHAELS)
 - One must be from the faculty of a school within this state that has programs to train persons to become professional counselors or marriage and family therapists (REES)
 - Two must be members of the public (ALEXANDER, HOWARD)
- A board member shall be removed immediately from the board if, during the member's term, the member:
 - Has been absent from three consecutive board meetings, unless at least one absence is excused;
 - Is not a resident of this state; or
 - Is not a licensee or a retired licensee whose license was in good standing at the time of retirement, if the board member was appointed to serve on the board as a licensee.

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: ORS 675.785

- Adopt rules
- Impose nonrefundable licensing and examination fees
- Maintain a register of current licensed professional counselors and marriage and family therapists and publish directory of current licensed professional counselors and marriage and family therapists.
- Investigate alleged violations, establish procedures to review and investigate the complaints of clients of licensees of the board
- Report biennially to the Legislative Assembly concerning the activities of the board
- Establish, examine and pass on the qualifications of applicants to practice professional counseling or marriage and family therapy.
- Grant licenses to applicants who qualify to practice professional counseling or marriage and family therapy.
- Adopt code of ethics for licensees.
