HB 2256

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/23/2017 AGENDA: Makes dietary supplements, as defined, food for purposes of Oregon Food Law and laws regulating sanitation for food and food establishments.

HB 2364

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/23/2017 AGENDA: Corrects inaccurate statutory reference.

#### Public Hearing

HB 2576

Permits part or product of animal species covered by wildlife trafficking prevention program to be distributed, sold or have legal ownership transferred to bona fide scientific or educational institutional for scientific or educational purposes.

HB 2533

Limits State Department of Agriculture bee colony registration fee and unit fee to colonies having primary purpose of pollinating agricultural or horticultural crops.

HB 2535 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires State Department of Agriculture to conduct four-year pilot program for replacing noxious weeds that supply pollen and nectar to pollinating insects with noninvasive forage plants offering similar benefit for pollinating insects.

HB 2214 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Expedited Housing Permitting Fund.
