## **Public Hearing**

HB 3232

Prohibits introduction of wildlife species into area outside species' current range without authorization from State Fish and Wildlife Commission.

HB 3040

Directs State Fish and Wildlife Commission to implement reduced fee schedule for hunting and fishing licenses for individuals who are not residents of Oregon but who pay Oregon state income taxes.

HR 3051

Expands permissible uses of Water Measurement Cost Share Program Revolving Fund.

HB 2893

Requires city to evaluate for inclusion in urban growth boundary agricultural land consisting predominantly of certain soil classifications with other first priority lands.

HB 2894

Permits cities to determine likelihood of development or redevelopment of land during review or evaluation of comprehensive plan or urban growth boundary expansion.

HB 2533

Limits State Department of Agriculture bee colony registration fee and unit fee to colonies having primary purpose of pollinating agricultural or horticultural crops.

HB 2535 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires State Department of Agriculture to conduct four-year pilot program for replacing noxious weeds that supply pollen and nectar to pollinating insects with noninvasive forage plants offering similar benefit for pollinating insects.

HB 2525

Modifies requirements relating to donating game meat to charitable organizations.
