HB 3044

- Modifies requirements for carrying dog on external part of vehicle.
- HB 2937

Permits accessory dwelling unit on land zoned rural residential and as conditional permitted use on land zoned for exclusive farm use.

HB 2938

Permits siting of recreational vehicle for residential purposes on land zoned rural residential and as conditional permitted use on land zoned for exclusive farm use.

HB 2456

Permits tax exempt landowner to develop affordable housing units on rural residential land with county approval. HB 3012

Permits owner of lot or parcel of at least two acres zoned for rural residential uses to construct new single-family dwelling on lot or parcel if owner converts existing historic home to accessory dwelling unit. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 2222 **

Directs Land Conservation and Development Commission to study potential conversion to regional land use planning process.

HB 3050

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-4-2017 AGENDA: Permits siting of commercial solar photovoltaic power generation facility on land not designated as high value farmland, on high value farmland under certain conditions and as conditional permitted use of land zoned for exclusive farm use.

Changes water management and conservation plan approval condition for extension of time to construct works or perfect right for municipal use of water.
