Requires State Forestry Department to identify Oregon-based contractors qualified to provide wildfire fighting personnel, equipment and other resources.
- HB 2027 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds to finance water storage projects and water distribution projects.
- HB 2030  
Prohibits state agency from restricting or closing access to state lands used for hunting until state agency has notified State Department of Fish and Wildlife and department has posted notice of restriction or closure for at least 30 days on department's website.
- HB 3151 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Appropriates moneys to State Forestry Department for 2017-2019 biennium to carry out integrated pest management program to combat Sudden Oak Death.
- HB 3228  
Modifies state wildlife policy.

Requires development of plan for Oregon Coast Trail.
- HB 3153 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to use dual-frequency identification sonar devices for counting fish.
- HB 3193 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Repeals Department of State Lands leasing requirements for kelp harvesting.
- HB 2099
