HB 2161

Provides that amendments to articles of incorporation or bylaws of credit union are automatically effective unless disapproved by Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services.

HB 2346

Directs insured institution or credit union to accept declaration rather than affidavit from Department of Human Services or Oregon Health Authority to pay claim on death of depositor.

HB 2262

Allows Employment Relations Board to employ and set salaries for personnel who are management service employees or unclassified service employees.

HB 2263 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Increases fee from \$500 to \$625 for third mediation session conducted by mediator assigned by Employment Relations Board to resolve labor dispute or labor controversy.

HB 2264 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Increases application fee for individual who applies to be included on State Conciliation Service list of qualified arbitrators for labor controversy.
