HB 3060

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/20/2017 AGENDA: Prohibits state contracting agency from entering into public contract with prospective contractor that has not certified that prospective contractor has policy and practice of preventing sexual harassment, sexual assault and discrimination against members of protected classes of workers.

HB 2671 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/20/2017 AGENDA: Establishes task force to study and consider issues related to liquor store agent compensation.

HB 3184

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/20/2017 AGENDA: Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to establish loan counseling program for residents of this state.

HB 2162 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires state contracting agency that awards public improvement contract with contract price of more than \$5 million to require contractor to employ apprentices to perform 10 percent of work hours on public improvement that workers in apprenticeable occupations perform.

HB 2184

Provides that contractor may award subcontract only to responsible subcontractor.

HB 2670

Provides that contracting agency, in solicitation for procurement, must require bidder or proposer to disclose violations of certain laws.

Work Session

HB 2855

Creates procedure for purchaser of real property to enforce contractual requirement for delivery of deed of conveyance without instituting suit or action.
