Public Hearing

- HB 2154 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Oregon State Lottery Commission to employ ombudsmen to assist small businesses that are or wish to become lottery game retailers or contractors.
- HB 2190
Modifies definition of "social game" for purposes of regulation of gambling.
- HB 2549
Authorizes Oregon State Lottery Commission to issue registrations to fantasy contest operators to organize or offer fantasy contests.
- HB 2761
Includes daily fantasy sports game in definition of "contest of chance" for purposes of gambling and gaming laws.
- HB 2971
Increases number of video lottery game terminals allowed on premises of race meet licensee that qualifies as video lottery game retailer to 50 terminals.
