Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3170

Extends collective bargaining rights to certain faculty members of public university with academic rather than administrative focus.

HB 3264

Directs contracting agency to pay small business within 15 days of receipt of invoice or due date for payment, whichever is later.

HB 3402

Limits hours that nurses employed in Department of Corrections institutions may work.

HB 3209

Removes from coverage as subject worker member or manager of limited liability company who holds direct or indirect ownership interest in limited liability company, including through one or more holding companies, regardless of work that member or manager performs for limited liability company.

HB 2857

Prohibits certain activities by, and specifies additional duties for, performing rights society in notifying business proprietors concerning proprietors' duties with respect to performing copyrighted musical works and in negotiating contracts for paying royalties for performing copyrighted musical works.

HB 2191 **

 $\hbox{**Subsequent Referral}(s) \ to \ Ways \ and \ Means$

Requires person to obtain or renew license from Secretary of State in order to serve as commercial registered agent in this state.

HB 2348 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Increases amount of revenue from business registry filings that Secretary of State dedicates to operations of office of Secretary of State from \$20 per filing to \$25 per filing.

HB 2356

Establishes requirements under which debt buyer may bring legal action to collect debt.

AGENDA (Cont.) April 12, 2017

HB 2562

Requires lender that has contract with person for reverse mortgage to send person notice that states that title to property that is subject to reverse mortgage remains with person and person is responsible for paying property taxes and related taxes on property.

HB 2567

Requires employers with 75 or more employees to provide 60 days' notice to employees and certain officials before ceasing operations, relocating or ordering mass layoff involving 50 or more employees.

HB 3060

Prohibits state contracting agency from entering into public contract with prospective contractor that has not certified that prospective contractor has policy and practice of preventing sexual harassment, sexual assault and discrimination against members of protected classes of workers.
