Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3209
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Removes from coverage as subject worker member or manager of limited liability company who holds direct or indirect ownership interest in limited liability company, including through one or more holding companies, regardless of work that member or manager performs for limited liability company.

Possible Work Session

HB 2193
Requires employer to pay employee equivalent of at least four hours of work if employee is scheduled or called in to work but, due to employer, does not work entire shift.

HB 2737
Requires Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to establish special construction standards for homes that have floor area of not more than 250 square feet.

HB 2971
Increases number of video lottery game terminals allowed on premises of race meet licensee that qualifies as video lottery game retailer to 50 terminals.

HB 3157
Directs Department of Transportation to regulate privately owned vehicles for hire, including taxicabs and limousines.

HB 3203
Requires contracting agency to perform analysis to determine whether constructing public improvement with contracting agency's own equipment and personnel will result in least cost to contracting agency.

HB 3233
Allows employer to pay accrued sick leave to employee who is employed on fixed-rate, piece-rate or commission basis at employee's fixed hourly rate.

HB 2936
Specifies that, for purpose of sick leave employee-count threshold, employee and parent, spouse or child of employee may not be counted if employee or parent, spouse or child of employee is director of corporation with substantial ownership interest, member of limited liability company or partner of limited liability partnership.
