#### Work Session

HB 2169

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/17/2017 AGENDA: Limits certain attorney fee awards to employee who prevails on claim against employer in wage and hour and employment cases.

#### Possible Work Session

HB 2193

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/17/2017 AGENDA: Requires employer to pay employee equivalent of at least four hours of work if employee is scheduled or called in to work but, due to employer, does not work entire shift.

HB 3420

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/17/2017 AGENDA: Ensures that private sector labor organizations and employers throughout state may enter into union security agreements to full extent allowed by federal law.
