SB 985 A

Exempts insurers that transact certain classes of commercial insurance from requirement to file rates or policy forms.

Work Session

SB 41 A

Authorizes Employment Department to disclose information in department records to public universities and Oregon Health and Science University to extent necessary to carry out planning, performance measurement, program analysis, socioeconomic analysis or policy analysis functions.

SB 42

Reverses amendments to statute made by Enrolled Senate Bill 1534 (2016) that were determined by United States Secretary of Labor to be out of conformity with federal law.

SB 298 A

Extends sunset for provisions making discretionary Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries' authority to prepare formal charges and pursue certain matters in court.

SB 330

Specifies changes to conditions under which insurer or supervising entity may terminate portable electronics insurance coverage.

SB 838

Excludes persons who are not developers of timeshares from compliance with certain provisions governing timeshares.

SB 980 A

Requires manufacturer to compensate manufacturer's franchisee for all labor and parts manufacturer requires franchisees to use to perform repairs on vehicles that are subject to recall.
