#### Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 279 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/24/2017 AGENDA: Requires that notice of nonpayment of wages or compensation to employer include statement that payment of unpaid wages or compensation to employee within 12 days limits penalty to 100 percent of unpaid wages or compensation owed to employee.

#### Work Session

SB 299 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/24/2017 AGENDA: Allows employers to limit number of hours of sick time that employees may accrue per year.

SB 664 A  
Prohibits agency from imposing civil penalty on small business under certain circumstances.

SB 901 A  
Specifies that amateur athlete is not employee for purpose of certain employment-related provisions.

SB 974 A  
Prohibits persons other than retail customers of vehicle dealer from making claim against vehicle dealer under certain circumstances.

SB 984 A  
Directs employer in specified industries to pay greater of daily or weekly overtime when employee is eligible for both in same week.
