#### Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2899  
Provides that ports may enter into intergovernmental agreements for any purpose permitted under ORS chapter 190.

HB 2900  
Authorizes ports to advertise activities of port and activities of others using port facilities.

HB 2901  
Increases threshold, from \$500,000 to \$2 million, of real property value that requires port to obtain additional appraisal before purchase.

HB 2902  
Authorizes ports to acquire, construct, maintain and operate shipyards.

#### Work Session

HB 2091  
Authorizes Public Utility Commission to use universal service fund moneys to encourage broadband service availability and to provide support to telecommunications carriers that provide both basic telephone service and broadband service.
