HB 2744 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue Amends definition of "tourism-related facility" to include improvements to real property that have substantial purpose of supporting, promoting or accommodating tourism or tourist activities.

HB 2768 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue Expands definition of "tourism promotion" for purposes of local transient lodging tax revenue expenditures.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2950 **

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to City of St. Helens for central waterfront redevelopment and Portland Harbor cleanup support project.

Work Session

HB 2160

Allows brewery-public house licensee to also hold off-premises sales license.

HB 2242

Restricts business development project to projects that result in, aid, promote or facilitate development of traded sector activities.
