Local Lodging Fee Outcomes

Public Hearing

- HB 2744 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Amends definition of "tourism-related facility" to include improvements to real property that have substantial purpose of supporting, promoting or accommodating tourism or tourist activities.
- HB 2768 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Expands definition of "tourism promotion" for purposes of local transient lodging tax revenue expenditures.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2950 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to City of St. Helens for central waterfront redevelopment and Portland Harbor cleanup support project.

Work Session

- HB 2153
Requires Oregon Business Development Department to establish voluntary registry for commercial interior designers.
- HB 2160
Allows brewery-public house licensee to also hold off-premises sales license.
