HB 2150 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission to allow manufacturers or importing distributors of wine, cider or malt beverages to file required statements and pay privilege taxes by electronic means.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3031

Specifies that person may petition Oregon Liquor Control Commission for privilege of designating specified area in this state as Oregon cannacultural area.

HB 3150 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Allocates \$2,100,000 of lottery revenue to Oregon Business Development Department to be used to issue grants or loans in support of redevelopment of Port Orford Cannery.

HB 3374 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue then to Ways and Means

Provides grants to certain counties that received Secure Rural Schools Program payments if voters of county approve local option levy or bond levy.

HB 3375 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Oregon Business Development Department to develop and administer program to issue grants to address tourism-related coastal infrastructure needs.

HB 2743

Directs Land Conservation and Development Commission to establish and implement pilot program to implement master plan for economic development on land adjacent to airport in rural area.
