HB 2968

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/10/2017 AGENDA: Requires Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule pilot program for single, coordinated process for parties to meet certain federal and state requirements for, and to obtain certain releases from liability for, cleanup of hazardous waste.

HB 3252

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/10/2017 AGENDA: Prohibits greyhound racing.

HB 2155 **

Extends sunset for tax credit for qualified equity investment.
