Work Session

HB 2744 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Amends definition of "tourism-related facility" to include improvements to real property that have substantial purpose of supporting, promoting or accommodating tourism or tourist activities.

HB 2768 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Expands definition of "tourism promotion" for purposes of local transient lodging tax revenue expenditures.

HB 3377
Directs Oregon Business Development Department to prepare plan and strategies to implement recommendations in audit conducted by Secretary of State.

Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 3172
Directs Oregon Tourism Commission to identify, designate and monitor tourism districts in this state.

HB 3144 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on Trade Practices.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3374 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue then to Ways and Means
Provides grants to certain counties that received Secure Rural Schools Program payments if voters of county approve local option levy or bond levy.
