Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3069
Directs Department of Human Services to conduct statewide study regarding early childhood education and services no later than July 1, 2018.
- HB 3447
Prohibits provision in instrument conveying real property that restricts use of real property as certified or registered family child care home or as premises of exempt family child care provider.

Work Session

- HB 2957 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes grant program for purpose of improving kindergarten student-to-teacher ratios in schools that are considered high poverty.
- HB 2985 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/13/2017 MEETING: Expands recipients eligible for subsidized employment-related child care and types of activities that may be eligible for subsidies.
- HB 3068
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/13/2017 MEETING: Directs Department of Human Services to conduct statewide study regarding family supports no later than July 1, 2018.
- HB 3087 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/13/2017 MEETING: Creates family and medical leave insurance program to provide covered employee with portion of wages while on family medical leave or military leave.

Note change: HB 2985, HB 3068 and HB 3087 have been carried over from the 4/13/2017 meeting; HB 3065 has been removed.
