Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for training and professional development of school district personnel on contents and implementation of Comprehensive Guidance and Counseling Framework adopted by department.
- HB 2529
Requires applicants for preliminary administrative license to complete coursework related to comprehensive school guidance and counseling programs.
- HB 2530 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Prescribes requirements for guidance counselors in schools.
