- HB 2419 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Provides funding for instruction of talented and gifted children based on amount per student.
- HB 2657 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on Out-of-School Youth.
- HJR 14
Directs Chief Education Office to work with Department of Education and school district boards to ensure that school districts provide quality civics education.
- HB 2261
Expands allowed responsibilities of Youth Development Council to include coordinating statewide services to youth who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer or questioning.
