#### Work Session

- HB 3015  
Allows school district and public charter school to implement nationally recognized high school assessments in mathematics, science or English if assessment complies with specified criteria.
- HB 3138 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Allows school district and post-secondary institutions of education to apply for funding to form K-20 partnership.
- HB 2693 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes grant program under which Department of Education awards grants to school districts for percentage of certain student transportation costs for which school district does not receive any amount in distributions from State School Fund.
- HB 2554  
Requires public charter schools to comply with public school requirements related to provision of school food programs.
- HB 3215  
Requires school district to obtain approval from Department of Education before entering into funds diversion agreement for payment of debt service on pension obligation bonds.

*HB 3215 is scheduled for the sole purpose of referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.*

#### Public Hearing and Work Session

- HB 3293  
Provides that school district may not deny participation in interscholastic activities by student who attends public charter school.
- HB 3395  
Allows school district to employ person licensed as school social worker to provide to students in kindergarten through grade eight services that school counselor provides.

Establishes Accomplished Teaching Program within Department of Education to encourage and assist teachers in earning national board certification.
- HB 2246 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes Task Force on the High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness Act.

**Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

- HB 3409  
Exempts from compulsory school attendance requirements children who are present in United States on nonimmigrant visa and who are attending accredited English language learner program in preparation for attending private high school or college.
