HB 2246 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Establishes Task Force on the High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness Act.

Work Session

HB 3215
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Requires school district to obtain approval from Department of Education before entering into funds diversion agreement for payment of debt service on pension obligation bonds.
HB 3215 is scheduled for the sole purpose of referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means without recommendation as to passage.

HB 2845
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Directs Department of Education to convene advisory group to develop statewide ethnic studies standards for adoption into existing statewide social studies standards for public kindergarten through grade 12.

HB 3395
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Allows school district to employ person licensed as school social worker to provide to students in kindergarten through grade eight services that school counselor provides.

Establishes Task Force on Assessments of Children Who Are Deaf or Hard of Hearing.
HB 3351
Directs Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to prepare annual report related to duties, powers and functions of commission.
HB 3038
Directs Department of Education to conduct study on methods for improving and stabilizing school funding.

Work Session

HB 3208

Prohibits Legislative Assembly from enacting certain legislation related to education.

HB 3318

Establishes procedures for conducting functional behavioral analysis and for developing, reviewing and revising behavior intervention plans for students with individualized education programs or 504 Plans.

HB 3358

Directs Department of Education to convene advisory group related to English language learner programs.
