- HB 2331
Extends until January 2, 2025, sunset for Oregon Department of Administrative Services program to make compressed natural gas available for use in motor vehicles.
- HB 2268 **
Modifies underground storage tank fees. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Public Hearing

- HB 2134
Repeals sunset on collection of additional moneys for low-income electric bill payment assistance.
- HB 2722
Prohibits enforcement of condominium irrigation requirements by association of unit owners following finding or declaration of existing or likely drought conditions or adoption of certain rules by association.
- HB 2111
Prohibits inclusion of provisions prohibiting installation and use of solar panels for obtaining solar access in declaration or bylaws of planned community.
- HJM 5
Urges Congress to continue to appropriate funds for Hanford Nuclear Reservation cleanup, with specific focus on funding for remediation of ground water contamination.
