#### Public Hearing

- HB 2319 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Creates Mental Health Regulatory Agency.
- HB 2388  
Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to deny, revoke or suspend authority of pharmacy benefit manager to conduct business in Oregon if pharmacy benefit manager fails to comply with applicable statutes, rules or orders.
- HB 2552 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to operate, on each campus of Oregon State Hospital, facility to provide short-term mental health treatment and residential care.
- HB 2660 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Oregon Health Authority and Department of Consumer and Business Services to create and implement educational campaign about options available to breast cancer patients for insurance coverage of breast reconstruction surgery, breast prostheses and breast forms.
- HB 2839  
Prohibits eye bank, tissue bank, procurement organization, hospital or physician from considering any disability of potential recipient of anatomical gift and from requiring individual with disability to demonstrate ability to perform major life activity substantially limited by disability upon receiving anatomical gift.
