Public Hearing

- HB 2015
Directs Oregon Health Authority to reimburse doula at rate of no less than \$350 per pregnancy for services provided to medical assistance recipient.
- HB 3090
Requires hospital to apply discharge policy for release of patients admitted to hospital for mental health treatment to release of patients from emergency department following treatment for behavioral health crisis.
- HB 3091
Requires specified facilities to provide certain case management and behavioral health services to individual who presents at facility experiencing behavioral health crisis.

Work Session

- HB 2114
CARRIED OVER FROM 3/29/2017 AGENDA: Prohibits issuing initial prescription for opioids or opiates to adults for outpatient use in quantity exceeding seven-day supply.
- HB 2339
CARRIED OVER FROM 3/29/2017 AGENDA: Prohibits health care provider or participating health care facility from balance billing patient covered by health benefit plan or health care service contract for services provided at participating health care facility.
- HB 2882
CARRIED OVER FROM 3/29/2017 AGENDA: Requires governing body of coordinated care organization to include representative from at least one dental care organization that serves members of coordinated care organization.
- HB 2527
Allows pharmacists to prescribe and dispense self-administered hormonal contraceptives.
- HB 3135
Requires medical assistance coverage of long-acting, reversible contraceptive devices during hospital stay for labor and delivery.
