HB 2582 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes University Research Fighting Fund to provide state moneys to public universities or Oregon Health and Science University when universities seek federal research grants.

HB 2668

Requires governing board of public university to obtain approval from Legislative Assembly or Higher Education Coordinating Commission in order to increase tuition and mandatory enrollment fees by more than four percent annually.

HB 2782 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Authorizes issuance of bonds under Articles XI-G and XI-Q of Oregon Constitution to finance expansion of Oregon State University-Cascades campus.

HB 2729 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to work regularly with public universities and community colleges to analyze and evaluate effectiveness of previously adopted open educational resources and to increase number of open educational resources used in courses.

HB 2314

Permits Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish by rule minimum standards required for graduating from hair design, barbering, esthetics or nail technology schools.
