Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2311

Makes 40-40-20 higher education goals relate to Oregonians completing education, rather than to all adult Oregonians.

Work Session

HB 2313

Revises types of programs considered accelerated college credit programs for purpose of requirement that school districts provide accelerated college credit programs.

HB 2666

Gives community college recognized student government authority to establish process and allocate mandatory incidental fees, subject to refusal under certain circumstances by board of education of community college district or president of community college.

HB 3423

Exempts person serving in Oregon National Guard from requirement to enroll in community college courses within six months of attaining previous highest level of education in order to qualify for Oregon Promise grant.
