- HB 2998
Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study and develop recommendations on best methods for creating common course numbers for courses within Oregon transfer module and for ensuring courses within module are commonly accepted as general education requirements at post-secondary institutions.
- HB 3437
Establishes legislative findings and intent regarding Oregon Talent Council.
- HB 2531 **
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Workforce Investment Board for Worksystems, Inc. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2965
Establishes Task Force on Workforce Development for People with Disabilities.
- HB 3288
Requires each public institution of higher education to submit annual report containing information about noninstructional staff employed by institution to Higher Education Coordinating Commission.
- HB 2582 **
Establishes University Research Fighting Fund to provide state moneys to public universities or Oregon Health and Science University when universities seek federal research grants. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2701
Prohibits Higher Education Coordinating Commission from placing career school or agent on probation, or suspending or revoking license, unless sanction is authorized by hearing officer.
- HB 3337
Creates limited landscape construction professional license.
- HB 2862 **
Allocates \$350,000 to Nursing Faculty Loan Repayment Program. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 3423
Exempts person serving in Oregon National Guard from requirement to enroll in community college courses within six months of attaining previous highest level of education in order to qualify for Oregon Promise grant.

- HB 3335
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/11/2017 AGENDA: Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to develop plan for enabling community colleges to offer associate's degree completed in coordination with credits earned in apprenticeship or training program.
- HB 2864
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/11/2017 AGENDA: Requires each community college and public university to establish cultural competency oversight committee.
- HB 2313
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/11/2017 AGENDA: Revises types of programs considered accelerated college credit programs for purpose of requirement that school districts provide accelerated college credit programs.
- HB 2929 **
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/11/2017 AGENDA: Directs State Treasurer to establish student loan refinancing guarantee pilot program. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
