\*CARRIED OVER FROM 3/7 AGENDA\* Requires Oregon Health Authority and Department of Consumer and Business Services to report to Legislative Assembly each calendar quarter on implementation of requirements to reimburse cost of child abuse medical assessments conducted by community assessment centers.

Establishes Homeownership Repair and Rehabilitation Program within Housing and Community Services Department to provide grants to eligible nonprofit organizations to provide financial assistance to persons in low income households for repair and rehabilitation of residences.
- HB 2010  
Establishes Task Force on Addressing Racial Disparities in Home Ownership.
- HB 2996 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Designates Act as Oregon First-Time Home Buyer Savings Account Act.
