- HB 3262  
Requires Department of Human Services, in collaboration with other agencies, to adopt rules related to prescription of psychotropic medications to elderly persons and persons with disabilities.
- HB 2011  
Directs Housing and Community Services Department to administer study to assess disparities between federal and local calculations of fair market rent.
- HB 2959 \*\*  
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Human Services to administer general assistance project. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2433 \*\*  
Directs Housing and Community Services Department to establish pilot program in which department constructs low-income senior housing development on school district land and school district rents to low-income seniors at reduced rent in exchange for classroom assistance. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2919  
Requires certain facilities providing residential accommodations for persons 55 years of age or older to notify Oregon Health Authority prior to providing food services for residents.

HB 2347

Extends for two years Department of Human Services' authority to prescribe employability assessment and orientation process for job opportunity and basic skills program and limit number of participants and activities of participants in program; to require single parent of child under two years of age to participate in job opportunity and basic skills program; to deny request of recipient in temporary assistance for needy families program to enroll in educational institution as allowable work act

HB 2661

Requires long term care referral provider to be certified by Health Licensing Office.

HB 2944

Limits landlord assistance under Housing Choice Landlord Guarantee Program to damages awarded in a judgment following a hearing in which landlord proves amount of damages.
